Exhibitor Appointed Contractors

An Exhibitor Appointed Contractor (EAC) is a company hired by the exhibitor, who is not an employee of your company or of an official show contractor. EACs are most often independent installation & dismantle companies but also include supervisors, technicians, photographers, audiovisual, floral, furniture, flooring, and any other contractors who are not the official contractors of the show, but provide a necessary service at show site for the Exhibitor.

Exhibiting Company Requirements

- Submit a [Notice of Intent to Hire an EAC](#) by 19 June 2026 to ensure your EAC can gain access to the exhibit hall. An EAC cannot complete this form on behalf of the exhibitor.
- Provide the EAC with any necessary information pertaining to the exhibit hall (i.e., utilities, order forms, dates, hours, shipping information, show guidelines, etc.)

EAC Requirements

- Comply with all show guidelines in the [Terms and Conditions](#) and [SIGGRAPH Display Guidelines](#).
- Email a Certificate of Insurance (COI) to sales@rainprotection.net including all liability coverage requirements outlined below by 19 June 2026.

COI's must be emailed to sales@rainprotection.net by 19 June 2026. If you do not have your own, or would rather not use your insurance, insurance is available for purchase through Rainprotection, the official insurance supplier for SIGGRAPH 2026. EAC Liability Insurance Requirements

When attaining the certificate of insurance (COI) from a carrier, please note the following requirements:

- Coverage must include Commercial General Liability in an amount no less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence, \$2,000,000 aggregate.
- Insurance must be in force during the complete facility access dates of 15 July 2026 - 24 July 2026.
- The certificate holder must be listed as: The Association for Computing Machinery (ACM), 1601 Broadway, 10th Floor, New York, NY 10019-7434.
- Additional insureds must be listed as: Association for Computing Machinery (ACM), Tradeshow Logic, SIGGRAPH 2026, Freeman, and Los Angeles Convention Center.
